If You Have a Good Thing Pass it Along.

Under this head we propose to inaugurate an exchange system of household helps and your favorite recipes. We believe you will be interested in this and ask your co-operation in making the Home Department of mutual helpfulness to the community.

Lemon Cream Cake.

Cream one half cup of sugar with butter the size of egg. Add three eggs, one at a time, beating the mixture thoroughly as each is added. One-half cup of milk. One and one-half cups of flour sifted with one teaspoon baking powder. Bake in three small layer pans.

Lemon Cream for Filling.

Grated rind and squeeze juice of one lemon. One cup granulated sugar mixed with one tablespoon of constarch. Mix this thoroughly. One cup of water put over fire in double boiler or sauce pan. Set in hot water. Add lemon juice and grated rind. Stir cornstarch and sugar slowly into the hot water. The slower you put it in the smoother the cream will be. Boil until thick and add one-half teaspoon of butter. Allow to cool. Spread on layers of cake and ice top.

Oatmeal Cookies.

One-half cup butter.
One-half cup lard.
One-half cup sugar.
One cup raisins and currants.
One cup chopped English walnuts.
One cup flour.
Two cups oatmeal.
One teaspoon soda.
One teaspoon cloves.
One teaspoon cinnamon.

Press into a loaf and let stand over night. Then slice into thin slices and place one inch apart into pan. Bake in a moderate oven.

Popcorn Cakes.

Put nicely popped corn through a clean coffee or meat grinder, then stir it into molasses candy, using as much as will make the syrup very stiff. Spread on a greased slab and roll an inch thick with a buttered rolling pin. Cut into cakes and let become cold. The molasses syrup only wants to be boiled until it forms a stiff ball in cold water. Easy to make and good.
