Mazarin's Bible.

The "Mazarin Bible" is so called because the first copy described was found in the library of Cardinal Mazarin at Paris in 1700. It was printed by Gutenberg between 1450 and 1455 and was the first complete book ever printed from movable type. Its distinction is not in any peculiarity of text, but in the fact that it was the first book of any kind so printed under the personal supervision of Gutenberg, the inventor of printing. There are known to exist twenty-six copies, worth from \$15,000 to \$20,000 each.
