THE LIBERTY LOAN HONOR FLAG.

A new and distinctive feature will be introduced in the Third Liberty Loan campaign, and every city or town in the country which subscribes more than its quota of Liberty bonds will be awarded by the Treasury Department an Honor Flag.

The flag will be 36 inches wide and 54 inches long. The body of the flag will be white with a red border, and three broad blue vertical stripes denoting the patriotic service, and will favor road Third Loan. The flags, which will be of building of a permanent nature. the same quality as the flags of the navy, are already being manufactured and will be awarded as fast as the right to fly them is won. Though awarded by the Treasure Department, they will be distributed by the Liberty loan committees of the different districts.
