



The new man-power bill which would extend draft age limits to 18 and 45, inclusive, was introduced in both houses of congress.

Provost Marshal-General Crowder urged the immediate enactment of the administration's man-power gramme and suggested September 5 as registration day for the 13,000,000 men between the ages of 18 and 45, whose names are not already on the nation's selective service list.

Unless immediate steps are taken FIVE DAYS' FREE TRIAL on guarto provide additional men, General Crowder said the weekly registration of men as they attain 21 years of age will be necessary to fill the draft DR. RAYMOND E. WATTERS quotas September 1, when only 100,000 of the 1918 registrants will be available.

The bill would amend the present selective act so as to require the registration of all men between 18 and 20 years and 32 and 45 years inclusive. Composition of Mica. Mica, so named from its being easily divided into glistening scales, consists of silica and alumina, associated with magnesia, soda and lime in varying proportions. Thus there are potash mica, consisting of silica, alumina and potash, and magnesia mica, in which the alumina is partially replaced by magnesia, passing-as the proportion of magnesia increases-into soft talc. which is chiefly composed of silica and magnesia.
