At Chickamauga the Confederacy made a supreme effort to recover ground lost at Vicksburg and Gettysburg. The Confederate plan was good, its army had a small but telling superiority in numbers, its leadership was excellent, its valor unquestioned, and fortune seemed to smile on its bold enterprise.
