

That organization has celebrated its ninth anniversary. Not many young institutions have given so convincing an account of themselves.

It wants particularly more volunteer leaders-especially men who have had military experience abroad. That want should be promptly, coplously, gladly met. There could hardly again be a conjuncture so favorable for impressing upon the very tissues of boys' consciousness a vital page in American history and in the history of democracy and of the world,
