

NOTICE OF ESTIMATED AND PROPOSED TAX LEVY FOR SHERMAN COUNTY FOR 1932

Notice is hereby given that on December 12, 1931, the Budget Committee of the County of Sherman, Oregon, will be in regular session at the County Courthouse in Moro, Oregon, at the hour of 10 o'clock a. m. and any taxpayer of Sherman County, Oregon, will be heard in favor of or against the proposed tax levy as hereinafter itemized.

ITEMIZED STATEMENT

Prepared in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 118 of the 1921 General Laws of Oregon as amended by Chapter 28 of the Session Laws of 1925, showing an estimate of the amounts of money required to be raised by taxation by Sherman County, Oregon, for the year 1932, to maintain each department of the County Government, County Office or County Officers, and for each improvement, the maintenance of each County building, structure or institution, and for the salary of each County officer or employee, and for the improvement and maintenance of public highways, roads and bridges, and for other contemplated expenditures.

Also showing the probable receipts of Sherman County, Oregon, from sources other than direct taxation upon real and personal property for the year 1931; the approximate amount of the balance of the various funds of Sherman County, Oregon, upon January 1, 1932, and the amount of indebtedness of Sherman County, Oregon.
