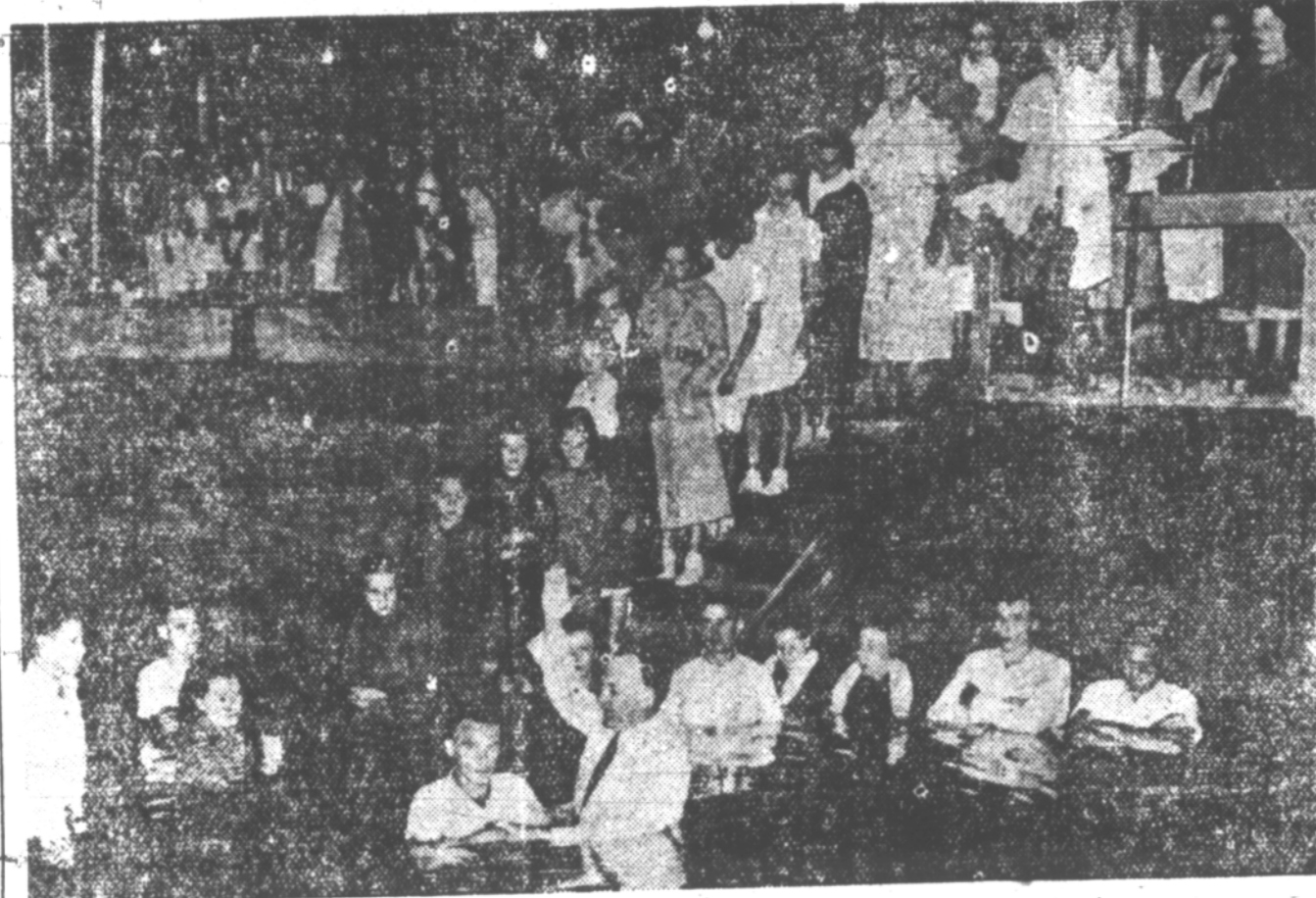

## FACTS FOR DRIVERS

More automobiles have traveled the highways of Oregon during the first six months of 1938 than during any similar period in the state's history, Secretary of State Earl Snell said today.

He bases his statement on the fact that oil companies reported record breaking sales in Oregon up to June 30, and also paid in more gasoline tax money than during and previous first half year. The total tax paid from January 1 to June 30 was slightly more than five million dollars, representing the sale of more than 100 million gallons, approximately 100 gallons for every inhabitant of Oregon, during the six months.</
