Mr and Mrs Del Eakin came up from The Dalles Saturday to spend the day at the ranch with their daughter, Mrs Myrl Smith.

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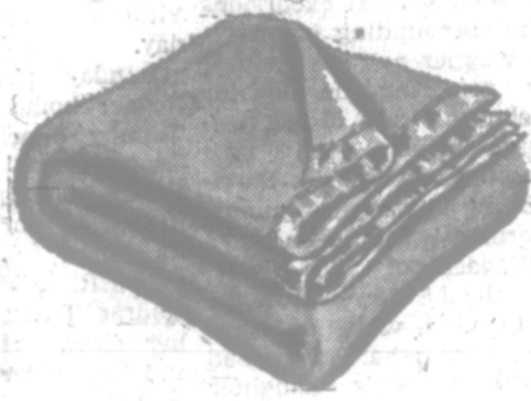
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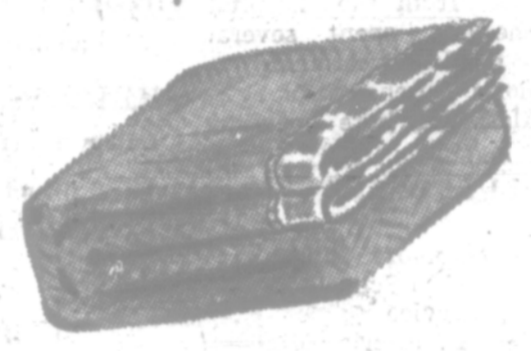
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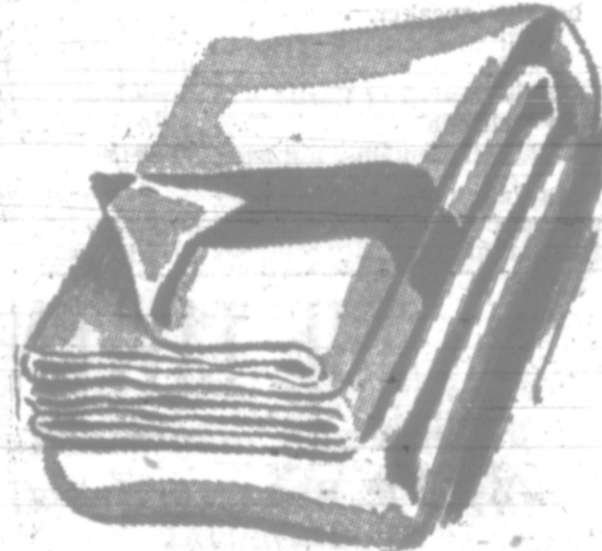
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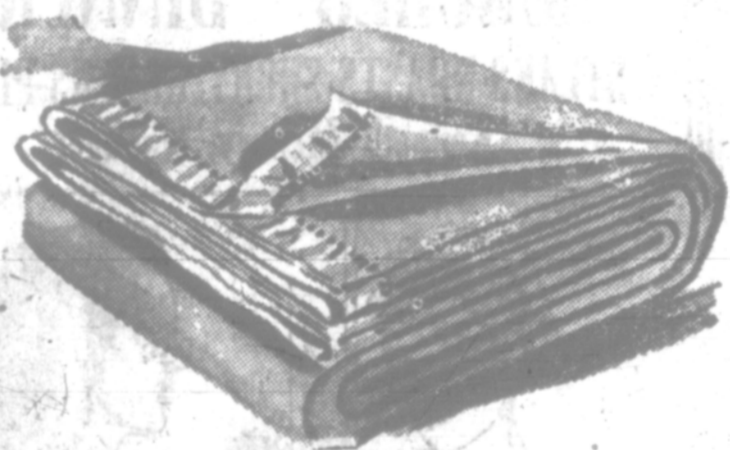
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
