

## New Pump Going Into New Moro Well

Installation of the new pump in the city's new well is being done Thursday and Friday with a crew from the Pump Pipe & Power company handling the operation. The pump is designed to throw in excess of 100 gallons per minute from the well.

A new pump house and a new pipe line to the cistern are in and a big meter to give the city a record of how much is pumped will be installed also. A check against the amount pumped and that sold will be kept.

Harry Holzaphel of The Dalles a land owner of this county, was in Moro Thursday to attend a weed control meeting.

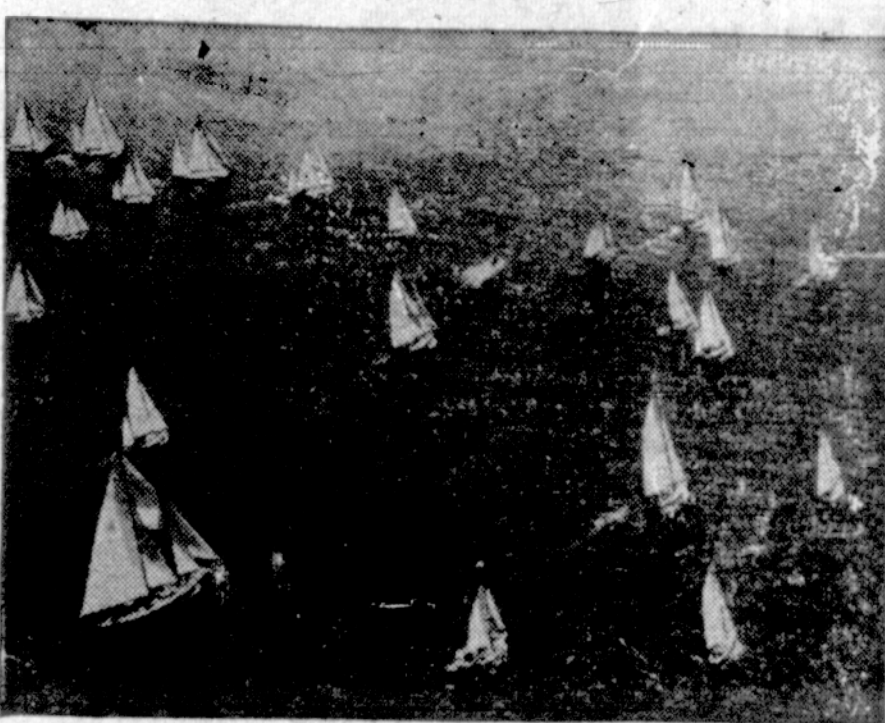

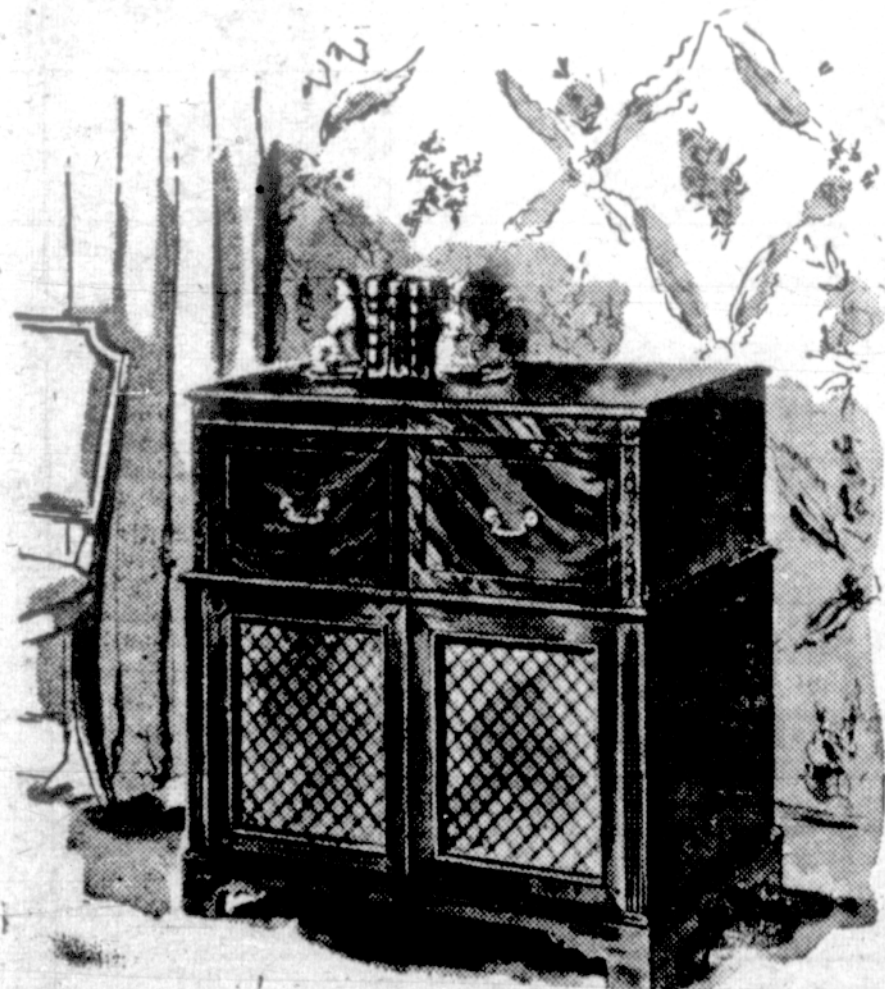
