Mr and Mrs Del Eakin of The Dalles spent Sunday visiting their son in law and daughter, Mr and Mrs Myrl Smith.

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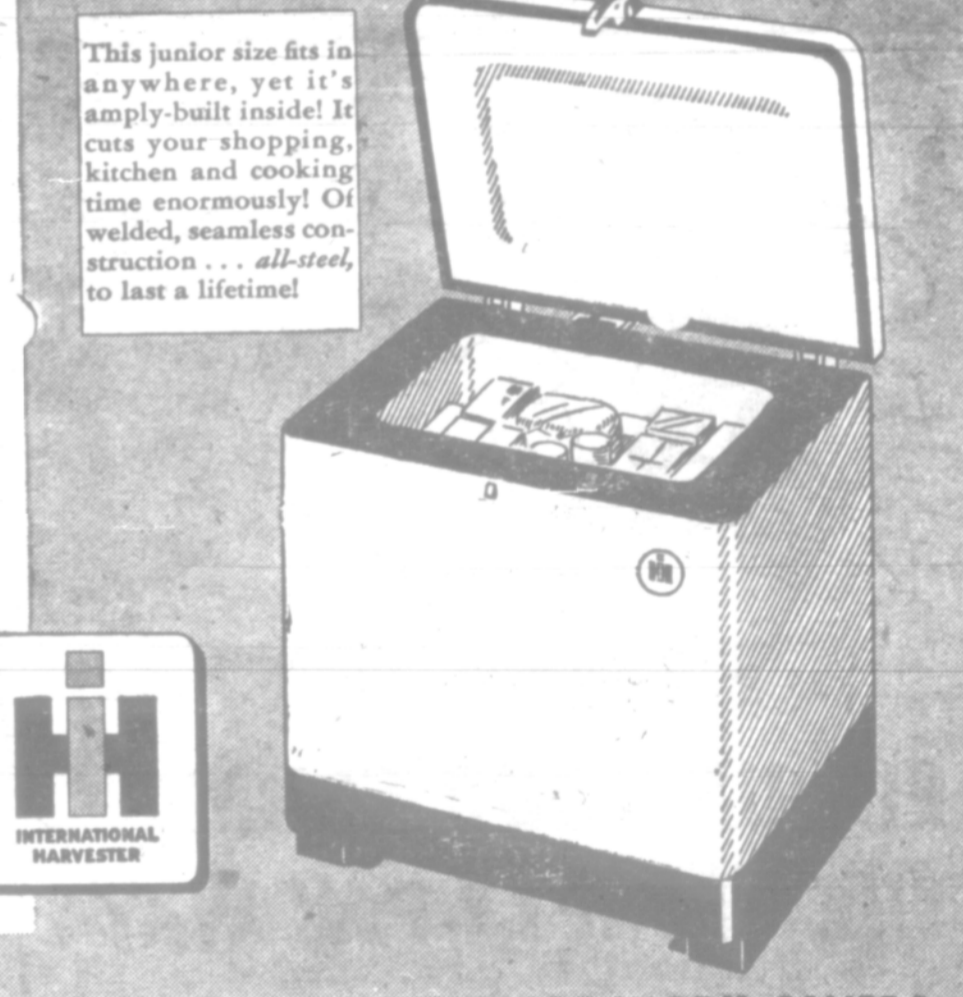
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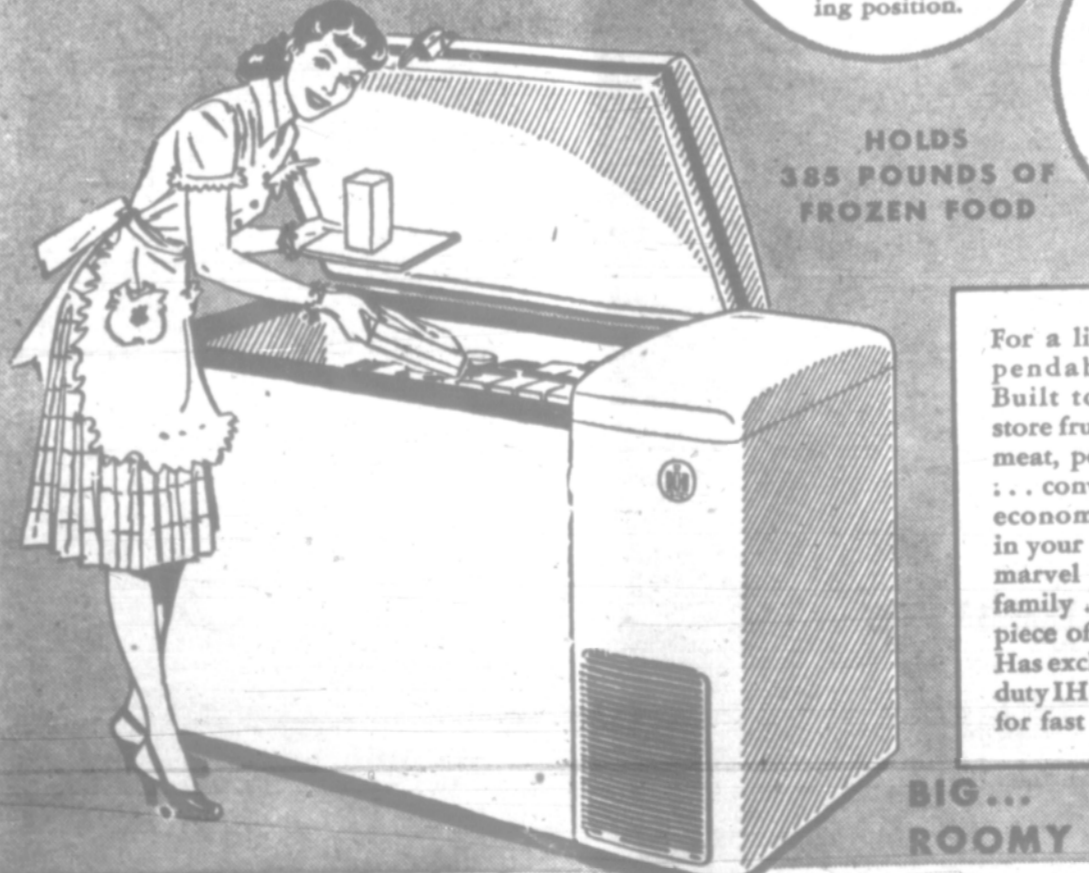
