WHOSE OX
Protest in Portland as echoed by the metropolitan papers over the proposed imposition of an income tax by the city are very revealing.

Reaction of Portlanders is almost absolute proof that if taxes were levied on a local level there would be less of them. Portlanders know who would pay the proposed tax. It would be them.

Remembrance tells us that if such a tax were proposed for the state the reaction would be less violent. Perhaps because misery loves company, perhaps because the effect of the tax might be to obtain some tax money not paid locally, or to receive the benefit of such tax indirectly.

There is little but grumbling against a nation-wide tax because the job of organizing a protest is too great. The taxpayer just moans in his beard or shouts to his neighbor but he pays.

It is when taxes are levied locally and collected by people we know and spent for easily seen things that tax protests are awakened. The people know how much they are paying and how much they are getting.

Actually tax money is more efficiently spent by smaller governments than by large. A dollar goes little when dragged to the city hall and out to the job. A little more is lost when it goes to the county seat, more yet when it goes to the state capital. When a dollar is taken back to Washington, D. C. and back it looks like a dime on arrival at the local spending grounds.

Tax money collected by a state or national government and then distributed to local or state agencies for expenditure is usually wasted in part. It being spent by men who have no responsibility for its levying or collection. Example: the cost of Oregon schools would be less were it not for the basic school fund.

Actually Portlanders may as well pay an income tax as property tax. Better yet, the city could well reduce some of the functions it has assumed and be economical with others. But the point is that they protest when they know that the tax will be paid by them, that it is aimed right at their pockets. If we did that with all taxes there would be fewer of them.

CVA
Northwesterners are being bombarded by argument for and against a CVA and actually the controversy doesn't seem to be clearing the thinking of many people.

Although there is little likelihood that a CVA bill will be passed at this session of congress, there will be one eventually in all probability.

Certainly everyone realizes that there will soon be development of the valley of the Columbia on a scale greater than the present dams indicate. There is no question but that the federal government will foot the bill. On that much there can be agreement.

The question is about control. Unless something new is discovered in governmental relationships the federal government will eventually control the program if it puts up the money.

What the northwest is interested in getting is control during the

planning period so that practical men, informed men of the northwest can have something to say. The northwest wants the job to be done under enough local control so theorists will not prevail and the east will not dictate policy.

In Tennessee the TVA has assumed control of the entire state, economic, social and political. It has succeeded in producing more electricity than before although Tennessee has far fewer farms electrified than has Oregon. It controlled floods by flooding the low land on a permanent basis. Navigation is not so important there.

Most northwesterners are in better economic position to be independent than were Tennesseans. It is not expected that they would take so kindly to federal administration. It is not necessary.

The army engineers have a long time program which has been in existence for many years. The reclamation service has a similar program. Upon these any development of the Columbia basin will be based. Citizens of the northwest who are opposing the CVA theory want the army engineers and the reclamation service to go ahead with their plans. They do not want an over-all board to do the directing but prefer the known methods of the engineers and the reclamation service.

That is what the argument is about. It is not that some want the Columbia basin developed and some do not. The question is whether to go ahead by proven methods or accept some new scheme with eastern control. On that basis there should be little question about what the northwest would choose if it had the chance.
