and Misses Margaret Olsen and Yvonne Dupree went to Antelope creek Sunday to picnic and Antelope attended.

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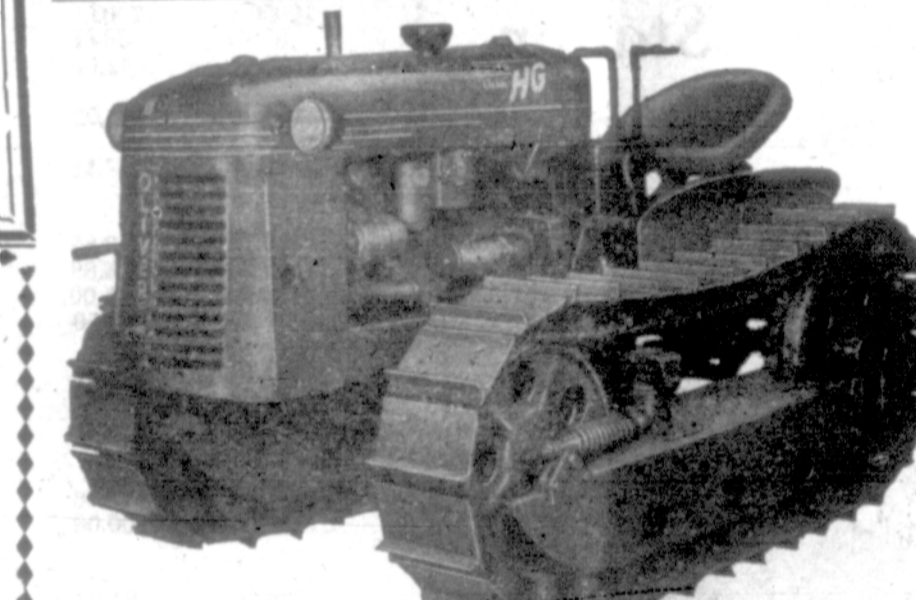
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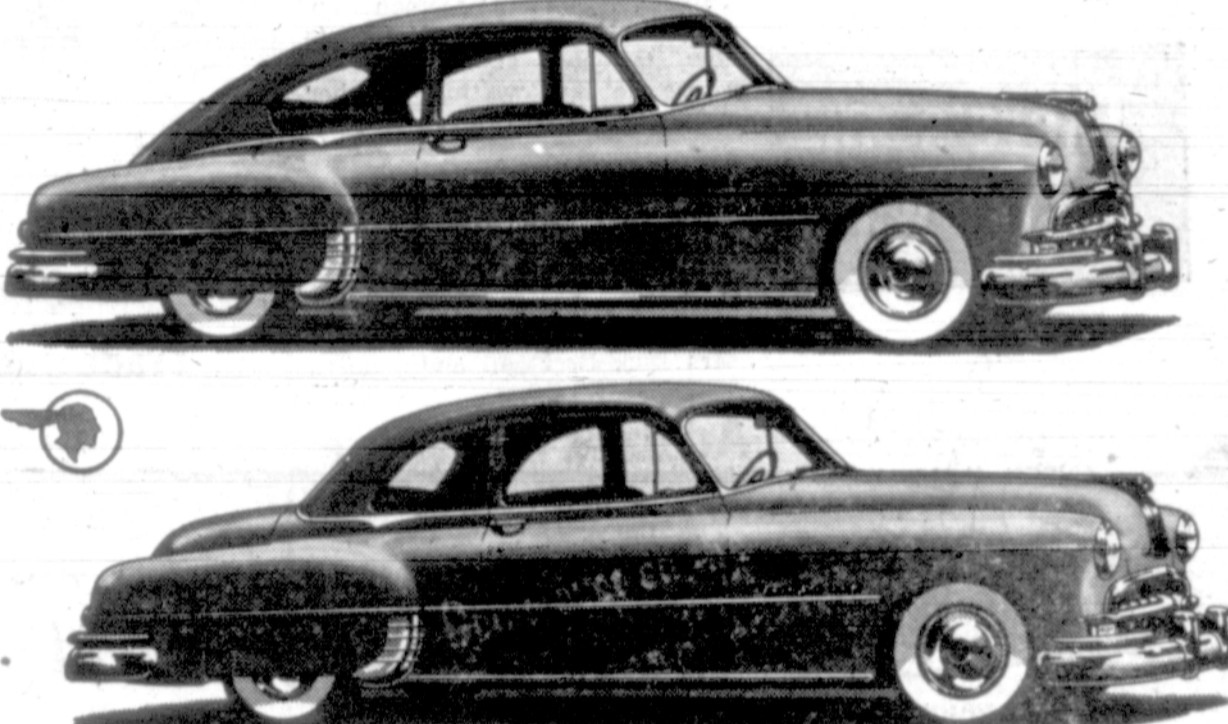
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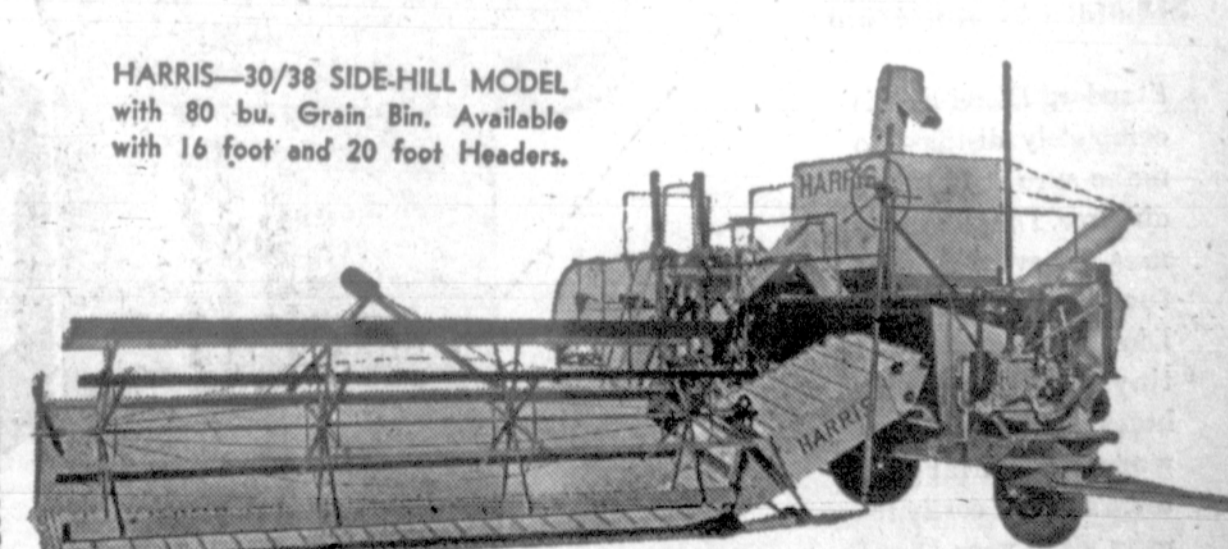
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
