Mr. and Mrs. A. Douma drove to Prineville Sunday to visit her father who lives near there.

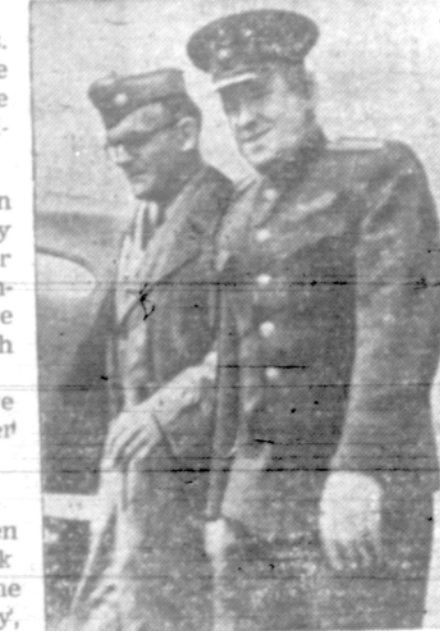
