STOCK SHOW PAGEANT

A subject for controversy which may or may not get into the newspapers is the one about the historical pageant that is taking the place of the horse show and rodeo at the Pacific International livestock show in Portland this week.

Comments vary from "culture in a cow barn"; "something educational for a change"; "My God, no horse show and I went and bought tickets."

Of the 14 episodes about half are very well done. Different organizations are responsible for each which accounts for the quality variation. As a change perhaps the pageant will be found enjoyable to enough people to make it pay and that shouldn't be hard when it is considered that costs must be far below that of the usual performance. There may be drama to the show, but there is little excitement comparable to a bucking contest.

We don't have much of an idea who attended the evening performance at the Portland exposition. Some farmers and stockmen, surely, and many city dwellers. Will they come to be educated in the history of the state or only for the thrills of watching the trotting thoroughbred and the rope dodging calf? Will those who tread the cold concrete by day, gasping at the well rounded sirloins, the filling udders, listening to the shouting pitchmen, be content to view the necessarily crude pictures of history or will they go home to rest their aching feet? We imagine the more elemental things will be on the program again.

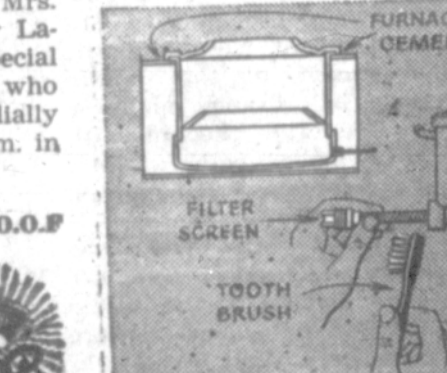
