

Morning Glory Control Explained

"Morning glory control can be accomplished on summer fallow land by application of 2, 4-D", states T. W. Thompson, county agent.

Sherman county farmers have reported good success in yearly application of 2, 4-D material on morning glory infested lands. Application rates for best results on summer fallow land should be with five pints of material per acre in the early bloom stage. Sufficient water to get uniform coverage and wetting of the plant is essential. Ground rigs should use upwards of 20 gallons per acre and airplanes 5 gallons.

Land in wheat may be effectively sprayed for morning glory in the dough stage or immediately following harvest. Application rates at this stage should be at 1 1/4 to 3 pints or material.

Tillage on summer fallow lands following spraying should be delayed for at least three weeks following application of the chemical. One rodding in the spring prior to growth for spraying to even emergence is desirable.

Land being spring cropped following summer fallow may be effectively sprayed in late fall if regrowth takes place. Periodic yearly spraying in summer fallow and crop ground for a number of years shows the real benefit of 2, 4-D spraying. Spraying twice in one year, where spring cropping is practical, aids in reducing stands and vigor of plants.

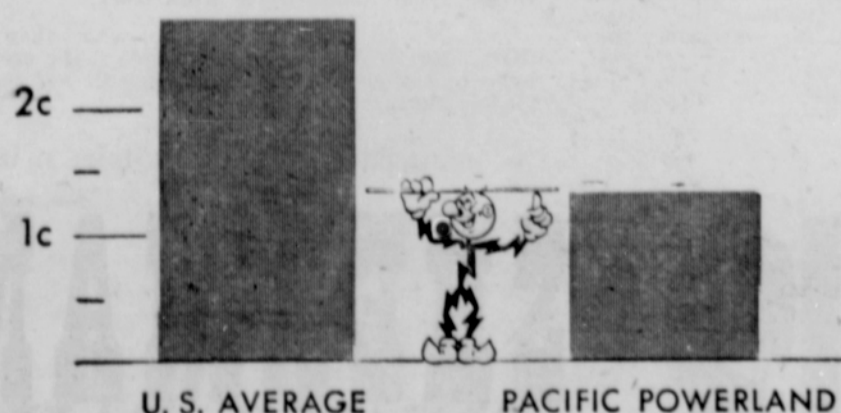
