FARM PROGRAM

The farm program so far as wheat is concerned is pretty well set for another year. There will be a good price and a smaller crop, or at least much fewer acres.

After that the position of agriculture in the national economy must be determined by a new law. The old one expires.

Biggest question for farmers in that year is the kind of law that is written.

In this Columbia river basin we grow lots of wheat although a very small percentage of the nation's total. Our freight rates are high on wheat to U. S. markets and our product is not needed at all to feed the humans nor the animals of the country. We will have to have some very good ideas or talk very big to have much to say about the program. Because we do have a group of farmers and farm advisers who have thought a great deal about the program of wheat it is, nevertheless, possible for our voice to be heard in making up the program.

Politics may make it necessary that there be a continuance of rigid price supports and, if so, it could be nothing but a temporary program in peace time. Farmers like everyone else must have some connection with the market and there must be some way to reduce the crop when there is a surplus and it should not be so drastic as the present voting procedure wherein the choice was between 90 and 50 percent of parity.

The two-price system is getting support and it might work under certain conditions but we are inclined to think that we, ourselves, might be the first to complain about it. In a crop as large as this one the average price could be pretty low.

The sales tax on bread for the benefit of the wheat price is a most direct method of keeping up the price and it has its advantages because of its simplicity. Even with the tax the farmer would get less than a quarter of the price of bread.

The government has, rightly or wrongly, established aids, direct and indirect, for nearly every sizeable economic group. It will not fail to include farmers and there is no evidence that any one in authority intends to try. The question is, what kind of a program will work to provide a fair income for food producers.

That question should not be settled without a lot of farmer discussion and study and each farmer may contribute his share.

TOMATOES
