**Overseas Markets Waiting
For Columbia Basin Products**

Practical aspects of foreign trade as related to Columbia Basin producers and distributors will be explored by regional, national and international experts at the Third Annual Columbia Basin Export-Import Conference to be in Portland November 13 and 14.

With the United States government promoting exports as never before, and with opportunities opening up abroad for American producers, Columbia Basin producers should get into the foreign trade act, according to George Henderson, general chairman of the Conference.

United States exports today amount to about \$20 billion annually, and should double by 1970, but only about five per cent of American producers of export commodities participate in this profitable business. Also, some \$15 billion is imported annually by the U. S.

Columbia Basin businessmen can tap this expanding trade, Henderson says.

To build local as well as national economy, Columbia Basin businessmen should learn the facts about participation in foreign trade. The Export-Import Conference will provide solid, factual information on the various aspects of foreign trade, in clinical workshops to cover such subjects as market opportunities, methods of reaching foreign markets and financing of foreign trade. "Success Stories" by firms in the export market will be related.

Portland, the "World Port of the Pacific", and other Columbia River gateways to the world markets for the Columbia Basin, are participating in the program, which is designed to attract those firms and individuals who are interested in getting their share of the foreign trade dollar.
