

### Short Course In Farm Management Being Offered

A farm management shortcourse is being offered to Sherman County farmers and other interested people during January. T. W. Thompson reports. The short course is being sponsored by the Sherman Rural Advisory Council and the County Extension office.

The short course will be similar to the livestock session held two years ago. The Farm Management and Agricultural staff at OSU will handle the teaching assignments. Twenty hours of in-

struction will be provided. The shortcourse is scheduled for January 9, 11, 16, 18 and 23 from 10 a. m. to 3 p. m. with an hour break for lunch.

Course topics include farm management and economic principles, farm records, farm budgets, income tax management, the corporation farm, credit and finance, and record analysis. Two other topics will be selected at a later time.

Anyone is welcome to participate. The shortcourse is not designed to make everyone an expert in the process of farm management but to acquaint people with the tools that can be used in this process. Thompson states Agriculture position required

more attention to this field and it is hoped the session will assist farmers in improving management of their farm business.

Pre-enrollment is requested to insure sufficient attendance. Farmers were mailed enrollment cards recently. Enrollment may be made by calling the Sherman County Extension office, Jordan 5-3230. Enrollment deadline is January 4. An enrollment fee will be necessary only if room rental or equipment is needed.

### Car Owners Can Help Registration

Notices mailed to Oregon car owners to remind them to renew their car licenses should be brought to the Department of Motor Vehicles when renewing in person or mailed with the check.

The department said today many people either are destroying or misplacing the renewal reminder form. This causes a delay in processing.

Use of the renewal form speeds processing for the department and enables the car owner to get a valid registration card much sooner, officials said.

The department sends the renewal card when validated by the department, but if the notice is lost or destroyed a new registration card must be prepared.

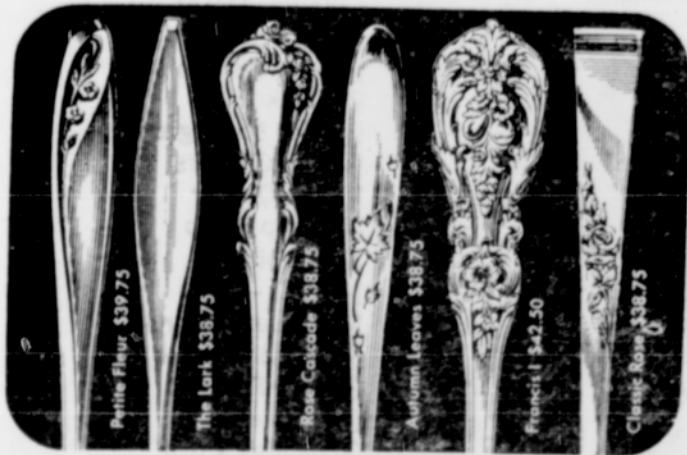
