THE WAR WILL CONTINUE

Conference Between Otis and the Filipinos Was Fruitless.

GEN. LUNA'S PROPOSITION DECLINED

Filipinos Admit They Have Been Defeated.

Gen. Otis Promises Full Amnesty in Case They Surrender.

Manila, April 29.—The conference today between General Otis and Colonel Arguetales and Lieutenant Bernal, who came from General Luna under a flag of truce to ask for a cessation of hostilities, was fruitless. It is understood the Filipino commissioners have given terms upon which the Americans will consent to negotiate. The Philippines admit they have been defeated and it is expected they will return with fresh proposals from Luna.

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AGUINALDO WANTS PEACE

Asks General Otis for a Cessation of Hostilities.

HIS REQUEST WAS NOT ACCDED TO

Otis Does Not Recognize a Filipino Government.

Report that General Luna Has Surrendered His Forces.

Manila, April 28, 6:25 p. m.—The Filipino advances for peace have been fruitless. Colonel Arguetales and Lieutenant Bernal, who came from General Luna under a flag of truce to ask for a cessation of hostilities, were received by General Otis and his staff. The Filipino commissioners have given terms upon which the Americans will consent to negotiate. The Philippines admit they have been defeated and it is expected they will return with fresh proposals from Luna.

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
