Boers Are Said to Be Occupying Laing's Nek. General Simons Preparing to Evacuate. Ugly Report From New Castle.

London, Oct. 5.—The Daily Telegraph has the following dispatch from New Castle, Natal, dated yesterday: "The Boer advance began today with a general movement of artillery."

London, Oct. 5.—Transvaal news is contradictory. Side by side with the announcement that Boers have occupied Laing's Nek is printed a dispatch from Pretoria stating that the Transvaal government has issued strict injunctions to commandants that British territory must not be invaded.

London, Oct. 5.—The Associated Press on reliable authority says the Boers are expected to cross the western frontier or to interfere with civilians, but to resist the passage of armed forces.
