It has long been the practice of Europe to flood the United States with drinks and other articles too poisonous to be accepted by their own people. Prof. Wiley has been trying to stop this, and congress has been buccooed by the many oily-tongued dealers in death and damnation infesting the lobby.

KING ALCOHOL.

The bill to relieve denatured alcohol from internal revenue has almost unanimously passed both houses of congress and become a law. Discussion of the subject has made it clear that the resultant benefit to industry will be considerable, but much of the detail which brings this feature to acute public comprehension has not found its way into print. Free denatured alcohol means a new and economical fuel, and a new source of light and power, and of profit to the farmer, assertions amply reinforced by the testimony of scientists, expert mechanics and business men. In summary: it costs from 6 to 15 cents a gallon to manufacture denatured alcohol. An acre of Indian corn, with a yield of 50 bushels, would make 310 gallons. An acre of potatoes, with a yield of 300 bushels, would produce 245 gallons, while certain varieties of potatoes will produce 500 gallons from a similar area. Sugar beets will yield more alcohol than either corn or potatoes. This covers the question of supply, and it interests the farmer.

As to the utility, one gallon of alcohol is quite equal to two gallons of kerosene for lighting purposes. Alcohol has not quite the heating power of oil or gasoline, but there is no danger, no soot, no odor. Hence it follows if the price of alcohol methylated is less than double the price of kerosene, its use, especially on farms and in villages of the country, would become enormous. During the past few months while we have been waiting for electric power to print The Observer with instead of steam now used, gasoline power engines have been adapted to the use of alcohol developing the fact that these may be used just as readily as the gasoline with 95 per cent difference in favor of safety. In all of this service it should be borne in mind that the use of alcohol requires no change in machinery where oil or gasoline has formerly been used.

The conclusion is sound that the greater use of this new agency in the production of light and power, marks an important development in a safe and sane business industry. A gasoline fire cannot be quenched with water. On the other hand, water seems to scatter gasoline and increase the danger. Alcohol fire is easily put out by the use of water.

Baling wire, thrown across the high tension feed cables of the Portland General Electric Company in Albina by mischievous boys, members of the notorious Albina gang, Sunday night, short circuited the current, burned out a pothead at the North Portland steam plant, started a fire in the power station at Oregon city, 14 miles away, and put the entire plant out of commission, throwing Portland and all its suburbs and Oregon city into utter darkness, tying up all street car traffic and putting everything out of commission that was dependent upon electric current for motive power.

HOME INSURANCE BUSINESS.

An Important Field Open Here in Oregon.

Insurance companies have sent orders to local agents to raise all insurance 25 per cent, excepting on residences, churches and public buildings. The rise is on account of the disaster in San Francisco. The insurance companies have met with a loss, and like Rockefeller after making a donation, must make good somewhere, so the harpoon is thrown into the dear people's good, and The Observer is opposed to the raise, on any such basis.

Ten years ago we opposed Life Insurance, and now look at the situation. Home fire insurance may as readily be adapted as home life. One of our arguments ten years ago is now the principal argument in Mr. Samuel's new system, "Keep the money at home." As Mr Samuel says:

The production of Oregon wheat, gold, hops, fruit, fish lumber and wool brings millions of dollars into Oregon each year. All these vast millions do little to permanently enrich the state, if the money is sent away for commodities made elsewhere, that are made just as good and fully as reasonable in our own state. The proper way to build up Oregon is to give "Made in Oregon" preference whenever it is possible to do so. After deducting death losses and dividends paid to policy-holders, life insurance premiums drained this state of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars for the year 1905, and nearly six millions in the past five years. Train Ran Wild

Engineer Lay Unconscious In His Cab Before Open Furnace.

His Assistants Were Driven From Their Posts by the Force of Gas - A Big Disaster Was Happily Averted.

A strange combination of circumstances led to a curious accident on the New York Central railroad near the Harlem river recently, but by good luck a disaster which might have involved much loss of life was averted. A massive locomotive, drawing sixteen cars laden with stone, whirled at full speed from Fifth street to Mott Haven, where, with the engineer unconscious on the floor in front of the open

The locomotive, which was on the main track and reduced the obstruction to junk.

Details of the accident became known through friends of the engineer, Elvy Devo of Poughkeepsie, who was taken to a hospital dying from burns and scalds. Three men who jumped from the train in the tunnel were lying unconscious at the track side when Devo last saw them. What happened there is a matter of conjecture.

The accident is said to have been due to a lack of ventilation in the tunnel. The engine of the train was left in the New York Central station soon after daybreak. It was drawn by a gigantic "pig-nose" engine. The top of its short smokestack clears the roof of the Park Avenue tunnel by a few inches. At Fifth street the big engine became stalled on a "dead center". Engineer Devo tried to get the pistons moving by starting the exhaust, but in spite of his efforts he could not get the big machine to turn a wheel.
