The Evils
of
OpportunismBy

THE disposition to protest against concentration of capital becomes a serious menace to law, order and civilization when misled by SELFISH INTERESTS.

This country has felt the influence of the lawlessness brought to America by refugees from foreign oppression, and this was cultivated by native demagogues WHO KNEW BETTER.

Most of the panaceas for the evils of the times suggested within a decade savor far more of the environment of the Socialistic dreamer than of the business common sense of the American people.

The demagogue and the sensational newspaper have seen their opportunity and made the most of it. The one helps the other, TO THE DIRECT PROFIT OF BOTH, and to the direct loss of the public. Both are the creatures of the gallery. Neither is the servant of the people.

WE SELDOM STOP TO CONSIDER THAT A POLICY OF MAJESTIC INACTIVITY MAY SOMETIMES SERVE THE STATE FAR BETTER THAN ONE OF MISDIRECTED ACTION.

While it is perfectly true that it is the function of an opposition to oppose, it is equally true that an opposition that does NOTHING BUT OPPOSE for opposition's sake is likely to remain in opposition always.

The journalistic common scold has done as much to hurt political conditions as the yellow journal, for while the yellow journal has its favorites and judges them not by what they do, but by what they PROMISE THEY WILL DO, the common scold, having no favorites, judges all public officials by what they have failed to accomplish.

What is wanted in this country is more positive action and LESS DESTRUCTIVE CRITICISM, more optimism and less pessimism, more hope and less despair. In the cons of the past, as we measure political history nowadays, government officials first made sure that they were constitutionally right and then went ahead. Now they FIRST GO AHEAD, leaving it to the attorney general to adapt the constitution to their consciences.

Strict constructionist has joined with loose constructionist, Democrat with Republican, in trying to apply the interstate commerce clause of the constitution in a way to make the fathers TURN IN THEIR GRAVES.

With the Louisiana lottery cases and the Addyston pipe case as their authority, they have assumed that the power to regulate commerce between the states carried with it the power to regulate commercial and all other activity WITHIN THE STATES and virtually to wipe out all state lines whatsoever.

We cannot prepare for our future by forgetting our past. If the constitution has outlived its usefulness, let us do away with it. If it has fallen short in any particular, LET US AMEND IT.

If new conditions have arisen, conditions not anticipated by the fathers, let us ADD TO IT.

If we are to alter it, let us do it in a cool and LEGAL manner—in the manner, in short, provided by the constitution.

BUT SO LONG AS THE CONSTITUTION REMAINS WHAT IT IS, THE FUNDAMENTAL LAW OF THE LAND, LET US OBEY AND REVERENCE IT!
