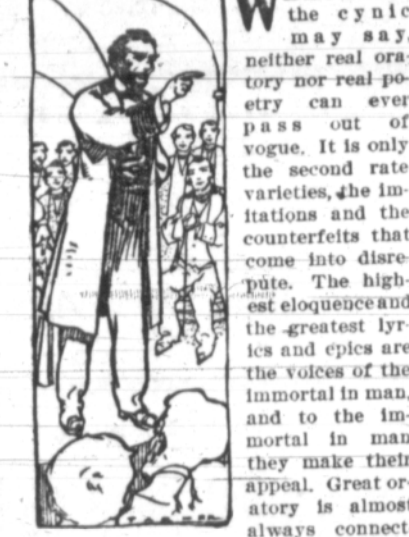

Lincoln was like no other speaker in history. His style is peculiarly his own. Not only are there no surplus words, but no surplus thoughts.

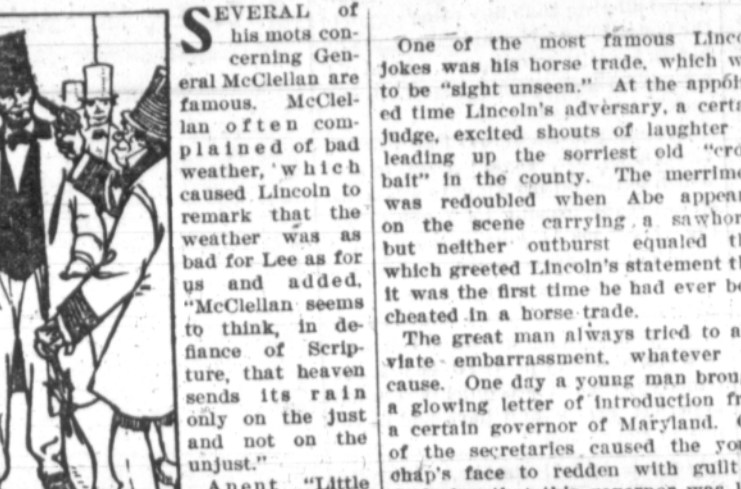
