Oregon has 81,826 registered republican voters, and 26,199 democratic registered, a total of 108,025.

Reclamation is costing the United States \$63,208,000 this year, \$10,000,000 of the sum stolen from Oregon.

Turkey is already \$500,000,000 in debt to French investors. This is one of the circumstances that explain why the French are slow to respond to another Turkish touch.

Students at Columbia University, N. Y., objecting to a new rule which forbids smoking in any of the lecture rooms or hallways of the college buildings will soon be found applying for positions as hostlers.

Uncle Sam was short of funds last month in the sum of more than \$21,000,000. The deposits 12 months ago was \$37,000,000. These deficits are accounted for on account of Panama Canal construction, bonds for which are still locked up in the treasury.

The strenuous life is seldom thought of as a branch of popular sport. It has been considered a form and means of cruelty to such animals as octopuses of business, predatory wealth and ananias-and-Sapphira clubs. But the French society of popular sports, learning of the enthusiasm of the strenuous Theodore, rewarded his intention to enter their competition, and awarded him a medal as a sportsmanlike exponent of the gospel of strenuousness. One of the peculiar conditions which often follow the operations of certain of the trusts, is to be seen now in Chicago, where the price of bacon has advanced from 11 cents a pound in 1900 to 35 cents a pound at the present time. Notwithstanding this fact, wholesale prices of hogs have declined from \$10 per cwt. six months ago, to \$8.49 per cwt. on the 1st. The pork producing cereal, corn, has also been constantly dropping in price recently without any effect on the rates charged for the cured product. It looks as though a little investigation was needed in this connection.

The auditor of the war department, to whom was referred Oregon's civil war claims, amounting to over \$193,000, has rendered an opinion to the effect that this is not a valid claim against the federal government and should not be paid. This holding is contrary to the findings of the court of claims, which two years ago held that the state was entitled to reimbursement to this extent on account of monies advanced during the civil war for equipment, clothing and subsistence of volunteer troops for government service. But we are everlastingly reminded from Washington that Oregon is "the fool of the family" of states.

Late Local Election Returns.

Jay Bowerman has lost the governorship; republicans electing all the rest of the state ticket.

Sherman county republicans elected their entire ticket, with the exception of Max Bull, who lost to J. C. Freeman on sheriff, by 305 majority.

Sherman county voted against state wide prohibition and also against Home Rule for cities. In the state at large prohibition lost heavily, and Home Rule has won. Sherman county has gone wet in the local option election by 32 votes; notwithstanding lawyers argue to the contrary, Moro precinct is as dry as it has ever been the last few years. Grass Valley and Wasco went wet.

Some argue that the Home rule amendment will allow Moro to go wet by special election, but the local option laws are not changed and they specify only "general elections," special, or city elections, do not count.

For the legislature Buckley is ahead in the three-cornered fight in this county by about 245 votes; Jackson and Mariner are comparatively even, which shows that Jackson put up a good scrap. It will take the returns from Gilliam and Wheeler to decide the issue.

We cannot expect complete returns from any outside source before next week.
