New Auto Law in Effect

Contrary to the supposition of many motorists the motor code is right now in effect. The reason therefor is that it was passed by the legislature with an emergency clause, which made it effective as soon as approved by the governor.

Consequently 30 miles an hour instead of the old 25 is now the legal speed limit on Oregon highways, thus conforming to requirements in California and most other states.

Another provision of the new law gives state, county or city authorities having jurisdiction the power to authorize speed contests. No such contests may be held without permits from the proper authorities, however, and the course must be fully and effectively patrolled for its entire distance.

About the only worry the Oregon motorist need give to his lights is to see that he has a white tail light and two white headlights visible for at least 300 feet ahead, and to be dimmed on meeting approaching vehicles.

If the car is not equipped with a dimming device, then the law makes it compulsory on the car owner to have a spotlight, so adjusted as to throw its light to the right side of the highway downward and so adjusted as not to blind occupants of an approaching vehicle. This spotlight, where the lights have no dimmers, is to be substituted for the lights when approaching and passing other vehicles.

Part of the joy is being taken out of "joy riding," at least for that species commonly known as the "roadhog," by a little amendment slipped into the motor vehicle law. This amendment forbids an autoist to speed up his car when another car is attempting to pass.

"Joyriders" it was explained, are sometimes wont to loiter along the road, especially where passing is impossible, causing great annoyance to cars following in the rear whose driver "is going somewhere and bent on getting there." When the impeded car attempted to take advantage of a good piece of highway for passing his more leisurely going pacemaker, this individual then "speeds up" until he has compelled the other machine to fall back to the ruts and dust in the rear, when he again resumes his leisurely pace, greatly to the annoyance and exasperation of the latter. The rule of the road which has heretofore governed such cases, it was declared, has had no effect upon the "joyriding road hog," therefore this attempt to insert a few "teeth" by way of enforcing the recognition of common courtesies.

National Prohibition Coming

About 3000 agents of the internal revenue service will be ready for the enforcement of national prohibition on July 1. This force will be used largely at the known "strategic points," where smuggling may be attempted and illicit trade lines are most likely to be established.

State and local officials are to be relied upon to look after the more ordinary and minor violations of law. If it is found that local officers are not co-operating effectively in a given district, federal agents are likely to go in and make a clean-up.

Regulations will be issued to govern in detail the making and distribution of liquor manufactured for medicinal, scientific and sacramental purposes, which is not to be interfered with, despite a wide impression to the contrary.

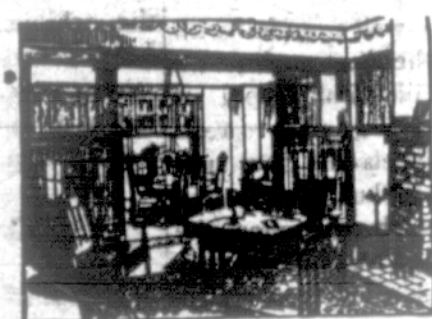
