

G. R. Hyslop, professor of farm crops, from O.A.C., spent three days of last week with the county agent, examining wheat fields reported in for certification. In all several thousand acres again passed the field requirements for certification and there is assurance of plenty of good seed wheat of superior quality.

Professor Hyslop was impressed with the prospects for a good yield over the entire county as well as with the condition of the summer fallow in general. It is his opinion, however, that much of the summer fallow in

the lighter soil sections is worked too fine by successive spike tooth harrowing and that a blade or spring tooth weeder could be used to advantage, killing the weeds and leaving more of the clods on the surface. For the fields having the larger weeds, Mr. Hyslop feels that there is no tool equal to the revolving rod weeder. A few fields in certain sections are exceedingly weedy, which means that there will undoubtedly be a reduction of yield next year of several bushels and the chances are that the wheat will be yellow berried.

Mr. Hyslop has always been a firm believer in turkey red wheat for Sherman county and was glad to notice that the turkey red line is gradually moving further south in the county. That this means better and more consistent yields for the south end of the county is the belief of Mr. Hyslop.
