Notes From Moro School

The Moro boys won their 5th victory February 12th when they defeated the Lone Hoopers by a score of 34 to 11. Out of the 11 points made by the Egg City boys seven were for fouls. They made only two field baskets during the whole game. In the first half our boys piled up a lead of 17 points in a series of field baskets that kept the referee hopping from our goal to center. The Moro players were nearly fagged out in the last half and fouled continually, consequently Lone made six points on penalties, making a total of two field and seven foul baskets. Our 34 points were from 17 shots from the floor. We made no scores from fouls. Andersen from Moro was high point man with 16 points.

The girls basket ball team added another victory by defeating the lone girls last Saturday. This makes the girls 5th victory this season with no defeats and with three more games scheduled an enviable season record should be made. The local girls led from the start, the score at the end of the first half reading 8 to 0. The lone girls came back strong in the second period and for a while were only two points behind the Moro girls, but constant passing and accurate shooting kept the lead to the end with the final score reading 18 to 9.

This Friday the Fossil boys will be here determined to clean up on Moro. This game will not be a double header, but is worth the money for three or four. Fossil claims the Championship of Eastern Oregon, but they've been defeated twice and we've still got our first time to be beaten. We are all coming out to do what Heppner and Ione did to them.

Next week our boys and girls go to Condon and the boys go on to Fossil. The boys will go to the later place Friday and will come back to Condon Saturday and meet the girls there. The Condon games are almost a cinch, but the one at Fossil will be a grand old fight.

Ione defeated Grass Valley Friday, the 11th, by a score of 15 to 13.

Two girls games have been arranged between Moro and Dufur. One will be played at Moro March 5th and the other at Dufur March 12th.

Large crowd was at the train Sunday morning to see Ione off. Several got on the train to say good bye and the train accidently pulled out, leaving them on. They spent about two hours at Biggs. On the way home they worried about what they were "going to get" when arriving.

"Heart Strings" at Moro Theater
The role of musician is not new to William Farnum, who will be seen as a violinist with a sensitive soul in "Heart Strings," the William Fox production which will be presented at Moro Theatre this Saturday.

From boyhood Mr. Farnum has been passionately fond of music. When only five years old he got hold of a cornet and stuck to the instrument with such persistency that he became a member of the famous Buckayott Silver Cornet Band at the age of eleven and made his first public appearance at a church fair in the Maine town.

Later when Farnum was starred in such productions as "Ben Hur" and "The Prince of India" it was always his wish that the musical accompaniment be of the highest order. He found that music inspired him to his best work on the stage. In "Heart Strings" Mr. Farnum plays Pierre Fournel, a young musician and composer. In making the various scenes in which he played the violin, he held the members of his company spellbound. Mr. Farnum on one occasion played the difficult Meditation from "Thais" with expression that would compare favorably with leading professional violinists.

William Farnum never has appeared in a more affecting love story than "Heart Strings" coming to Moro Theatre this Saturday. It is a story of self sacrifice through devotion for his sister, for when fame seems within his grasp as a struggling musician, he gives up all for her. The scenes are laid in a little village in Quebec and in New York city.

The School Teeth

Incisor is the Latin name for seissors. The four front teeth above and the four front teeth below are called the incisors because they cut like seissors. They were really intended to cut food, but it seems to be customary to use them to cut threads, bite off cigar ends, sharpen lead pencils, hold pins, nails, pillow slips, packages, tickets, transfers, and any thing else that requires a third hand. The two large teeth in the center above are called the upper central incisors. The two little ones in the center below are the lower central incisors. The teeth on each side of the central incisors above and below are the lateral incisors or side cutters.

If you will notice your own front teeth, you will find that the upper teeth close in front of the lower teeth. They pass each other just like the blades of a pair of seissors. These teeth enable us to bite off foods, particularly bread, fruits and vegetables. They support the center of the lips and help to give expression to the face. In speaking and in singing they have a very wonderful effect in moulding the column of air that carries the sound from the vocal cords.

The tip of the tongue does the most remarkable acrobatic stunts just back of these front teeth to make the delicate variation of space that is needed to pronounce words so that they will sound right to other people's ears.
