In preparation for the actual work of boring 3665-foot tunnel under the summit of the Cascade mountains on the Natron out-off line, steam shovels have cleared away loose dirt for the tunnel approach at each end of the proposed work.

Approval has been given to new regulations for the sale of ripe timber on the former Oregon and California railroad and Coos Bay wagon road land grant lands. It was announced by the secretary of the interior. The sales of timber will be conducted through the local land offices at Lakeview, Roseburg and Portland and the regulations provide for disposal at public auction to be conducted by the register of the land office in the district in which the timber is located. In the event the government succeeds in disposing of the timber contained in the grant lands, the state and counties in which the timber is located will receive a sum which may be as high as \$20,000,000. At the prices realized for timber in previous sales the disposal of such a large body would bring more than \$40,000,000. Under the act by which this land was re-vested in the government the proceeds from timber sales are distributed on a basis of 40 per cent to the reclamation fund, 10 per cent to the general treasury, 25 per cent to the state and 25 per cent to the counties.
