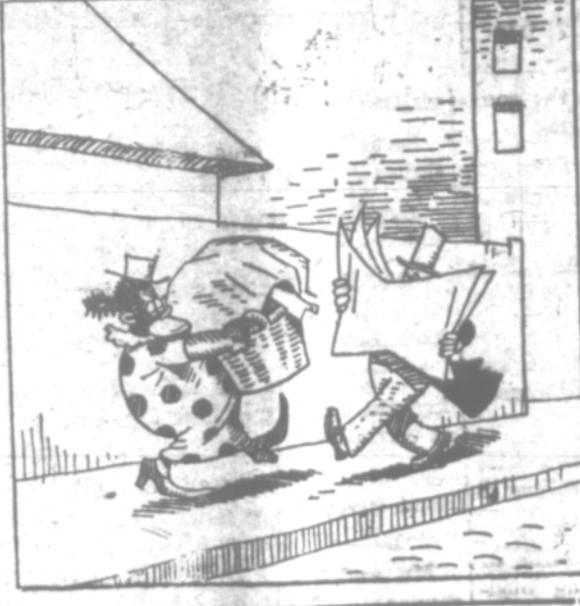
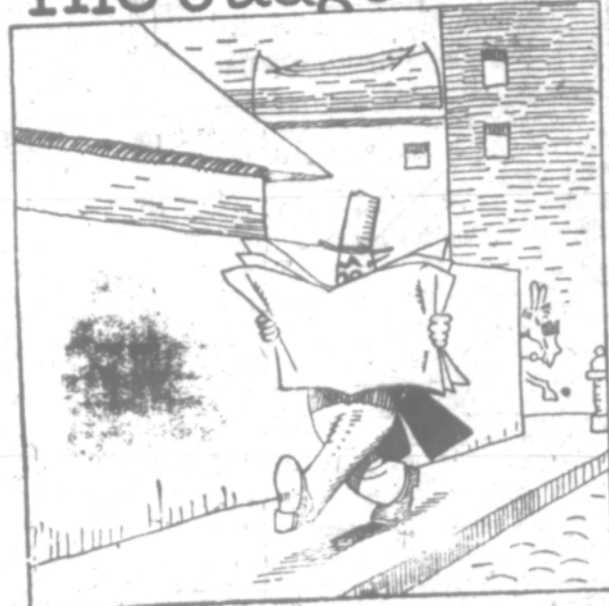

Announcement was made at Albany by the Linn county court that the two bridges crossing the Santiam river at Cascadia and Canyon creek on the Santiam road had been torn out and the road closed.
 Royal Anne cherries have begun to arrive at the cannery of the Eugene Fruit Growers' association, and while the crop is not heavy this summer, it is expected that there will be quite a long run on this fruit.
 The biggest shipment of shad roe ever received at Astoria came in on the gasoline schooner Roamer from the Anderson Fish company plant at Reedsport. The shipment consisted of 1550 cases and was insured for \$47,500.

Fire, thought to have been caused by spontaneous combustion in new hay, destroyed the apple packing house, barn, harvest equipment, a motor truck and automobile on the Dee ranch place of A. L. Stephens in the Hood River valley. The damage was estimated at \$15,000.

 WHEREAS, The trout and other fish inhabiting the waters of Fanno Creek, situated in the County of Polk, State of Oregon, and the waters of Frog (Ninneguan) Lake, situated in Wasco County, State of Oregon, are threatened with extinction from excessive angling, and from other causes; and the authority of law vested in said State Game Commission of the State of Oregon is desirous of protecting the trout and other fish inhabiting said waters:
 WHEREAS, The State Game Commission of the State of Oregon under Section 8, Chapter 275, Laws of Oregon, 1925, notice is hereby given that the waters of Fanno Creek, situated in Polk County, State of Oregon, and the waters of Frog, (Ninneguan) Lake, situated in Wasco County, State of Oregon, are hereby ordered and declared closed to fishing or angling therein in any manner for trout and other fish, on and after the 25th day of August, 1925, and it shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, or fish or angle for trout or other fish by any means whatsoever in the above described waters.
 Any or all persons taking, catching, killing, fishing or angling for trout or other fish in violation of this order will be prosecuted as by statute provided.
