AMERICAN GOODS BANNED

Doycott Against Japanese and British Extended by Cantonese.

Liverpool, Eng.—The Shanghai correspondent of the Liverpool Post says the boycott declared by the Cantonese government against British and Japanese shippers has been extended to include American goods.

The Cantonese government has officially notified American firms and steamship lines having offices in Shanghai that all American merchandise intended for Canton must be landed at Shanghai and reshipped in Russian or Chinese boats.

The reason given for the boycott is that quantities of British and Japanese goods have been smuggled to Canton under American labels. Under the new system, the merchandise will be examined when landed in Shanghai for reshipment.

Western States Tax Conference Opens

Portland, Or.—Taxpayers and experts of 12 states opened the third annual session of the Western States Taxpayers' conference here Tuesday.

Marlin B. Madden, Illinois representative in congress, chairman of the house committee on appropriations and one of the leaders in the tax reduction program at Washington, was the principal speaker of the conference and the guest of honor. Officials or delegates from each of the 12 states—California, Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Texas, Utah, Washington and Wyoming—attended the meeting.

63 Counties Put Steer 9271 Ahead.

Washington, D. C. — With the recount in 63 Iowa counties completed Daniel Steek, democrat, had a lead of 9274 votes over Senator Smith W. Brookhart, it was announced by the senate elections committee. In the same counties are 5322 contested ballots on which the committee will have to make a decision.

Idaho Cattle Not Victims of Anthrax

Boise, Idaho.—Post-mortem examination of cattle in Bannock county thought to have been afflicted with anthrax revealed that they died of hemorrhagic septicemia, the department of agriculture was informed in telegrams from Dr. W. R. Smith, director of animal industry.
