**School Book Change
 Again Made This Year**

Several new books have been adopted for use in the schools and it will cost parents a pretty penny for the new books when the schools open next Monday, as only a small allowance is made for any of the displaced books which pupils may wish to trade in.

The prices to be paid for the new books and allowed for the old ones are fixed in the contract between the state and the text book publishers and the local dealers have nothing to do with the prices fixed. The allowance for the displaced books varies from 6 to 23 cents.

The controversy over the adoption of text books has been settled by the State Text Book Commission.

The settlement of the question is the climax of a controversy which arose after the adoption of the new law that one third of the books be changed every two years. At this time, the contracts for the other two thirds of the books expired and there ensued an argument between State Superintendent Churchill on one side and the book commission with Governor Pierce on the other.

Through Churchill's efforts, the legislature had passed a bill giving him the authority to renew the old contracts at the best possible price. This bill was vetoed by the governor. Then the text book commission decided to advertise for bids for the books, whereupon the attorney general declared such action was illegal. However, bids were received August 20 and the old books re-adopted.
