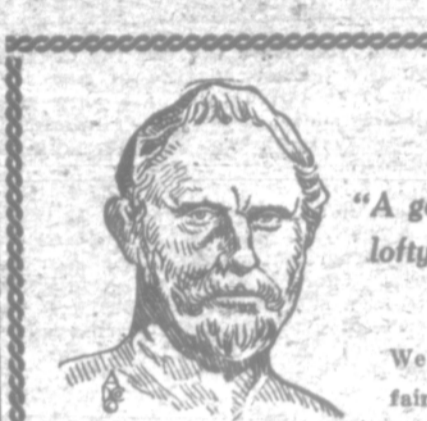
Bankers and business men of the leading towns of Taylor county, Texas, employed a county agent last spring and requested that he rigorously promote boys' and girls' club activities.

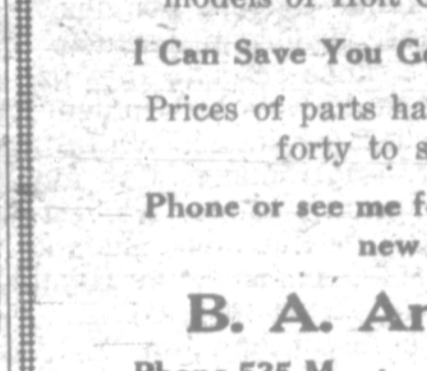

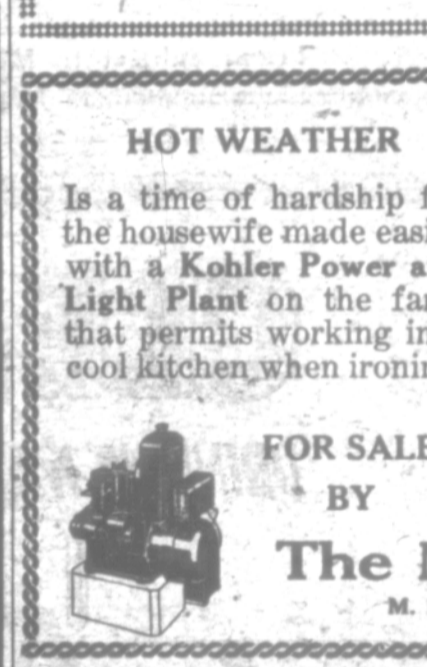
