WHY HANEY IS THE MAN

Cheap Water Freight Rates Will
Increase Wheat Prices

Oregon is fighting for her existence. Primarily an agricultural state, she is a victim of high transportation charges that takes from the farmer the modest profits he once made.

When Bert E. Haney was a member of the United States shipping board, he led the fight for cheap water transportation to the eastern markets. He stood for Oregon as few men have done in its history. He sacrificed a most desirable position in his fight for his home state. Most men will sacrifice everything for their job, but Haney is not of the "most men" caliber.

While on the shipping board, Haney made an intensive study of the state's transportation needs and has a more thorough knowledge of that subject than possibly any other.

Now Haney would go to the United States Senate to carry on the fight to get better shipping facilities and cheaper transportation, better harbors for the state, and an opportunity for the farmers to sell their products in the eastern market with a profit for the producer.

This is Oregon's need. Oregon doesn't need a man to stand by the president. It needs a man to stand by Oregon. The president didn't stand by this state when his help was needed and Oregon wants no senator to stand by the president in his opposition to the best interest of the state.

Haney would be a power in the senate on shipping matters. Because of the experience he gained when a member of the shipping board, he knows more about the subject than all the present senate combined and his knowledge and influence would be a most invaluable asset. Add to this his intense loyalty to his home state and it will be possible to obtain an idea of his value to the state in this body.

True Haney is a democrat, but nobody cared when he was fighting for the state's rights on the shipping board; when every citizen of Oregon was backing him to the limit; when he overcame the opposition of even the president by his intelligent and aggressive struggle. As a senator, it would make no more difference to the state.

The senate is the seat of the battle to come on this subject. Congress shapes the policies of the National Shipping Board. Bert E. Haney with his knowledge, ability, and aggressiveness can do more for the state in the United States Senate than he ever could on the Shipping Board.

For this reason, the people of Oregon regardless of political affiliation are lining up behind Haney's candidacy for election as United States Senator.
