LYCEUM COURSE FOR MORO

Five Date Lyceum Will Open at
Moro Next Month

All arrangements are now completed for the opening of a five date lyceum course at Moro beginning on Monday, November 8th, with the popular novelty artists, The Faubel Entertainers, who will present a skillfully interwoven program of drama, comedy, mirth and music. These will be followed on December 9th by Anthony Euwer, the Hood River poet, who won a name as an entertainer during the world war period when he appeared before audiences at soldier training camps. January 13th will be a south sea entertainment presented by Wherahike-Rawai, who is a distinguished native of New Zealand. February 16th will be a costumed musical evening by the Musical Arts Duo and on March 24th comes Lowell Patton and his artists, in an entirely new, unique and original musical program.

PIPE ORGAN RECITAL

Four Concerts on New \$8,000 Console
Pipe Organ Sunday

The formal dedication of the new \$8,000 pipe organ installed this week at the Empress theatre in The Dalles will be held this Sunday afternoon and evening with Mrs. G. E. Mathews at the keyboard. Doors open at 1:45 and at 6:45 with shows following 45 minutes later and a second concert at the close of each show. Special attractions have been secured for the shows to be presented. Organ concerts have also been announced for Monday and Tuesday at 4 p.m. and 9 p.m. each day. The pipe organ will also be used by Mrs. Mathews for interpretative music during the shows to be presented in the future at the Empress theatre.

Betting Machine

The backer places his stake in the receptacle appropriated to the horse he favors, and at the end of the race the supporters of the successful horse divide up all the money staked on the different horses, less 10 per cent, which goes to the owner of the machine.

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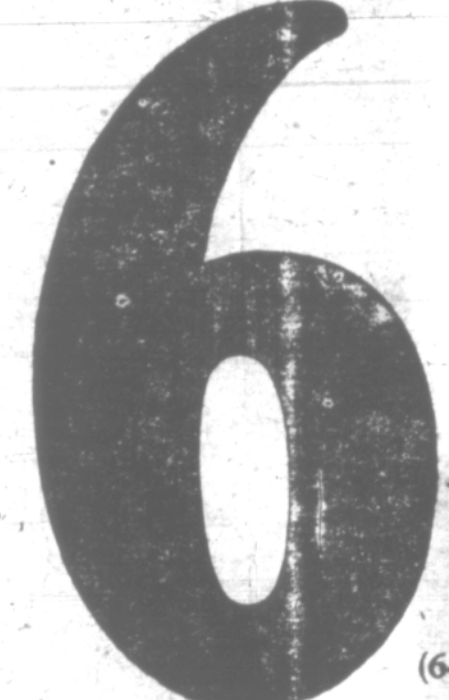

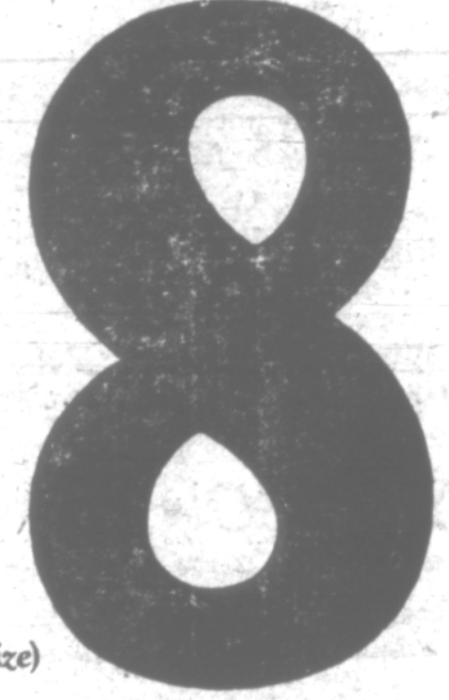

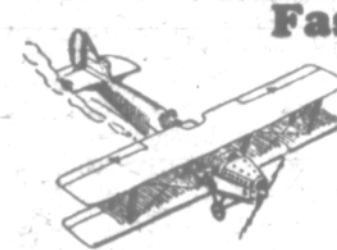
