Higher Wheat Prices

The wheat market continues quite strong. The condition of the new crop, which in many sections indicates a decrease in expected yield, has caused a stiffening of prices. A big decrease in wheat acreage in Canada is reported. The Kansas crop is expected to fall below that of 1926, the report being that the Hessian fly is doing much damage and the fields are very spotted. Oklahoma and Texas also report some uncertainty and the general tone from the wheat belts indicates that the market will not be glutted by the new crop. There is also some uncertainty yet in the wheat fields in Oregon as to whether the grain will recover fully from the effects of the cold spell.

A survey of 150 farms in the most prosperous regions of central China explains the small purchase power of the country in proportion to population. On 150 farms ranging from 0.6 acre to 34 acres the average net income was \$100 a year. This had to buy all the needs of a family aside from products of the farm. When 90 per cent of the people are farmers and coolies, there is no cause for surprise that the mass of the people cannot buy foreign goods. Modern transportation should raise the price of farm products. Development of mines and industry should employ many of the people and cause a general rise of wages, improving the market of farm products. This would raise the purchasing power of the whole population and enable the people to buy foreign goods.

The apple growers of the United States have started a movement to raise a fund of \$4,000,000 to carry on a four-year national advertising program by the growers and allied concerns to put the apple back in its old-time place of favor with the American people. The matter of participation in this movement by the apple growers of the northwest was considered at a meeting in Yakima, Wash., late in May.

No Collar or Tie, No Ride

Use of the street car is a business necessity in this country rather than a social event, but in Rio de Janeiro, the capital of Brazil, men must wear a collar and a tie and are requested to keep their coats on. Correct attire is required of all street car passengers and the rule is rigidly enforced. People in Brazil take their street car rides seriously, but in America the costume makes no difference, as we regard cars as a rapid and convenient means of travel.

"Man of the Forest"

Fifty tons of equipment, one hundred and fifty people, a mountain lion, two bears, foxes coyotes and other menagerie inmates had to be transported nearly four hundred miles into the heart of the Sierra Nevada Mountains for the filming of "Man of the Forest," a Zane Grey novel filmed by Paramount with Jack Holt, Georgia Hale and El Brendel in the leading roles.

Hauling a 12-ton generator truck to the top of a ten thousand foot peak over a rocky trail was one of the astounding feats involved in the transportation angles of production difficulties. What bridges there were over the mountain streams were of insufficient strength to support the motor mogul and had to be strengthened or rebuilt. Artificial lighting on an outdoor picture may seem somewhat of an anomaly but had to be utilized because of the few hours of daylight with proper photographic quality and because of the necessity for finishing the picture before a heavy snow came along to hem them in.

"Man of the Forest," arriving at the Moro Theater on Saturday, is one of the most popular of Zane Grey's earlier works. In the title role, Jack Holt saves the girl he loves from the machinations of an outlaw gang, who are trying to take a ranch away from her. The strife between Holt and the brigands, whom he outwits in a series of amazing exploits, forms the picture theme.
