"Leah the Forsaken."

Rudolph comes outside and Leah denounces him, at the same time invoking a curse against him and his offspring. Years afterward Rudolph learns the truth. Leah, with a tribe of her nationality, again appears near the city. She is assailed by a mob and threatened with violence. Seeking refuge at the nearest home she finds shelter at Rudolph's hearth and is protected by Madeline, who does not recognize her. Rudolph meets Leah. The latter discloses the identity of the schoolmaster, who stabs her to death. As he is taken to his punishment Leah dies with a blessing on her lips for Rudolph and Madeline.
