#### The Mineral Resources of Southern Oregon.

The gold mines of Southern Oregon were discovered in 1857. Since said date the mines of Jackson County have vielded to exceed thirty-five millions of dollars of gold in value, principally from the shallow placers and from prospect holes of an average depth of not to exceed twenty feet. This territory is in a great part drained by the Rogue River and its tributaries, name ly, Jackson Creek, famous for its rich placers; Gold Hill Gulch, at the head of which gulch was the famous Gold Hill pocket, from which in 1866 over half a million of dollars was extracted from an excavation 24 feet in length and 18 feet in depth; Water Gulch, Kanes Creek and its branches in the Blackwell Hills, noted for the richness of their shallow placers; Galls Creek, Sardine Creek Foots Creek and other streams and gulches too numerous to mention, all of which creeks and gulches yielded a golden barvest to the early miners who with pick, pan, rccker and sluice box delved and toiled for
