The letter says: "I have just served as a juror at a coroner's inquest held over the body of a man who was killed by the train at this place. The verdict was, "Death by accident." On his body we found one piece of paper, on which was the following: "Thomas McDonough, St. Paul, Minn." he had brown bair, inclined to be curly, rather stout built. The body was fearfully mangled. The body was found at 7:00 o'clock December 31st. There may have been foul play, as the body was found in the middle of the track some distance from town. I remember a son of Jas. McDonough and I think his name was Thomas. The man killed here was from 35 to 40 years old as near as I can judge."


