Office Abolished.

A Washington dispatch says: S. A. Clarke, an old newspaper man of Oregon, for whom Binger Hermann created the office of librarian of the General Land Office ten years ago, has resigned, it having been decided to abolish the office. When Clarke first came to Washington he ran Hermann's press bureau, but before Hermann resigned from the Land Office, he had a quarrel with Clarke and sought to remove him. Secretary Hitchcock, not because he loved Clarke more, but Hermann Jess, blocked Hermann's game and protected Clarke, through Clarke's office was unnecessary. Commissioner Balingier is reducing the Land Office to a business basis and Clarke is one of the first superfluities to be let out.

Will Build Road.

B. H. Harris, one of the incorporators of the Butte Falls Western Railway, presents the suggestion that the purpose of beating out the M. & C. L. line. "We have a contract to furnish \$1,800,000 worth of lumber within a stipulated time, and we propose to make good on our contract. To do this we find it necessary to open a channel of communication with our timber lands at or near Butte Falls.

"If we cannot get the Medford line we have ample capital to build our own line and will do it without consulting the people who are interested in throttling the existing line.

"We have completed arrangements for the establishment of a mill that will give employment to eighty men all the year around, and we are only awaiting the conclusion of negotiations for the right of way to begin work on the road as our franchise suggests.

"We shall locate our mills wherever it is most convenient. We have the rails and the rolling stock ready for transportation at a moment's notice and you may say to the people that we are going to do business regardless of the antics of the crowd that is scrapping over the oldline."—Medford Tribune.
