Holidays to be Extended to Jan. 1.

At the meeting of representatives of the different commercial bodies of Oregon held in Portland Sunday for the purpose of considering the question of asking Governor Chamberlain to call an extra session of the legislature to pass legislation desirable for meeting the effects of the money stringency and the resultant holidays, it was decided not to make the request at this time, but to request the governor to continue the holidays until the New York and Chicago bands resume specie payments. It was provided, however, that in case the holidays should extend longer than January 1, 1908, the governor should convene an extra session without further delay to pass necessary laws for the relief of the courts and for such other relief as may seem necessary.

Jackson County was represented at the meeting by W. S. Crowell and Wm. Colvig, of Medford, and E. V. Carter and Hon. L. L. Mullit, of Ashland.

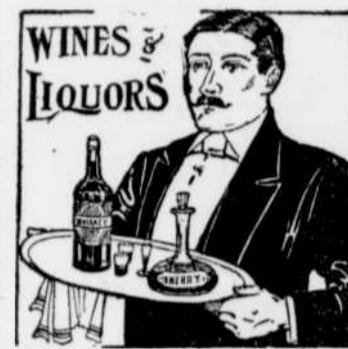
