The price paid for the lease on the property is \$100 an acre. The place consists of 200 acres of land, and on the land are some very fine prospects of coal. There seems but little doubt but that a wealth of coal underlies the land, and the new company will verify a few of the prospects before purchasing the property.

The work is to be undertaken within a short time, according to the interested parties, and will be carried on throughout the summer. If the prospects are as good as is thought the syndicate will purchase the property and will develop it.—Mail.

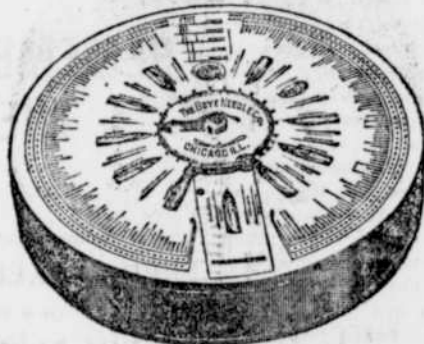
