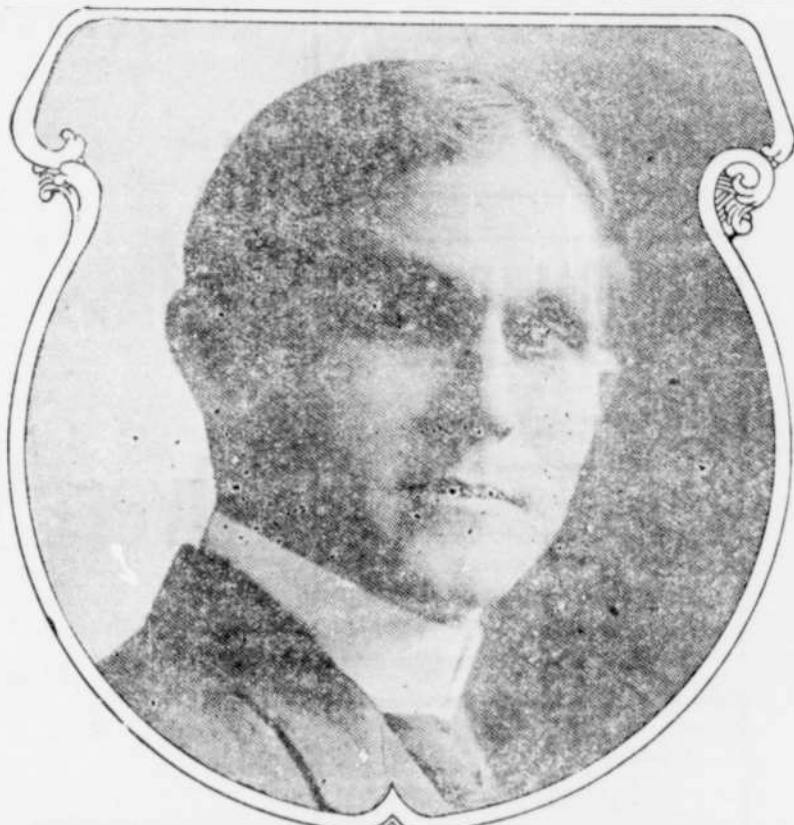


## Montaville Flowers
