### ALLEGED TORTURE PERPETRATORS HAVE HEARING IN GOLD HILL

A. E. Johnson of Jacksonville, arrested Friday morning with Mr. and Mrs. James Donoghue, at Medford, made the statement before the district attorney Saturday afternoon that he saw Donoghue and his wife assaulting Pat Bohan, elderly junk dealer on Plum street, in Medford, but denies that he had any part in the crime which means that all three will probably be charged with robbery by causing fear. Bohan is in a county seat hospital suffering with a badly burned foot, the result of the alleged hold-up, last Thursday night about midnight.

Johnson and Mrs. Donoghue were given a hearing in the justice court in Gold Hill, Saturday morning before Justice H. D. Reed, Mrs. Donoghue being charged with being intoxicated on a public highway and

Johnson with driving while intoxicated, both pleaded guilty and Mrs. Donoghue was sentenced to 10 days in the county jail and fined \$25. Johnson's sentence was deferred for a week as he was placed under \$2,000 bond pending action which might come from the greater crime. Donoghue was bound over to the grand jury under \$10,000 bail, this being his fourth offense.

In 1928, under the Reforestation Act (Clarke-McNary) of 1924, nearly 29 million forest tree seedlings were distributed by 34 states and territories for farm planting.

The landmark known as the Holy Cross, formed by two snow-filled crevices on a mountain on the Holy Cross National Forest, Colo., has been set aside by presidential proclamation as a national monument. The reserved area includes approximately 1,392 acres.

From 1906 to 1927, inclusive, the federal government has spent \$22,680,443 in Oregon for the protection, development and handling of the 14 national forests in the state. For that same period the government has taken in as receipts \$7,984,120 from the forests.

Under Idaho law it is now a misdemeanor to throw lighted smoking material from a vehicle, or otherwise deposit anything that may cause a fire in any place where it may directly or indirectly cause a fire resulting in damage to property on publicly or privately owned land. The states of Oregon and Washington have had similar laws, now for several years.
