a. To provide funds to employ certificated personnel, including additional teachers necessary because of increased enrollment and the state standard's requirements.
b. To provide heat, utilities, and janitorial services for school buildings.
c. To meet increased costs of textbooks, supplies and equipment.
d. To employ custodial and maintenance workers to maintain the school plant at state standards.

The amount of tax, in excess of the 6% limitation, proposed to be levied for said fiscal year is \$1,103,277.46.

Inflation In Sight

In the view of the Citizens Foreign Aid Committee: "In the beginning inflation is a wondrous elixir. But gradually it speeds up like the frightening rapids above Niagara; then suddenly nothing can stop its plunge. Inflation, born of profligate government spending, has started here. Since U.S. foreign aid began in 1946, our purchasing media—currency and checking accounts—have grown from \$106 billion to \$170 billion, while our gold reserve has fallen from \$24.7 billion in 1949 to \$13.7 billion on February 16, 1966. Meantime, U.S. foreign aid agencies have paid many billions of dollars for domestically produced commodities sent as gifts to foreign recipients. Since this takes goods out of our economy without a corresponding reduction in purchasing power, it is inflationary."
