CONTRACT FINISHED (Continued From Page 1) now. One hundred and fifty could be. The granite is quarried by hand, a slow process while modern machinery would speed it up, many times over. The granite is taken to the rail road finished ready for delivery, the polishing process, according to the owner should be done at the railroad track, and the room used now for this process could be utilized for quarry purposes. Briefly there is one of Ashlands greatest industries dormant or practically so for lack of capital. To hear W. M. Blair, owner of the six-forty acre tracts that adjoin each other, and which take in the granite deposits describe the possibilities that exist, would convince a chronic sufferer of biliousness that herein lies something that would bring a pay roll to Ashland. Mr. Blair secured the acreage ten years ago, after he had seen samples of the granite in other places. He made up his mind the first time he worked with it, that should the opportunity ever present itself, he was going to own an Ashland granite quarry. A contract in Portland netted sufficient funds for this purpose, and he opened up the quarries. Orders are stacked ahead, that will take months working in the antiquated manner that he has, to fill.
