

"FOOL PROOF"

Ottawa.—A \$3,000 folding, "fool proof" airplane now being produced at Peterboro, Ont., according to Capt. H. P. Ayers, aviation expert, is expected to solve the airplane housing problem. Wings pivoted to the fuselage will fold back and permit storage of the plane in a garage shipment in a long box. The plane will have a cruising time of seven hours, a speed of 110 miles an hour and will carry two passengers and 100 pounds of baggage.

NO XMAS BOXES IN PEN
