JESUS AN DSINNERS

International Sunday School Lesson for January 15, 1928 Golden Text: "I came not to call the righteous but sinners." Mark 2:17. (Lesson Text—Mark 2: 3-12 15-17)

Our lesson today tells of the novel and effective method by which four friends brought a sick man to Jesus to be cured by his miraculous power. The afflicted patient could not be carried directly to Jesus, so it was necessary for his benefactors to adopt an unusual course. They opened the roof sufficiently to lower the diseased man into the room below; thus their originality and perseverance in meeting the situation brought effective results.

It might be pertinent to point out how even today the crowd keeps many seekers from finding the truth. It is no accident that great philosophies have been originated by those who meditated and thought out the problems involved away from the distractions of society. The great religions of the world have been born in the quiet East, not in the rushing West. The average man or woman today needs nothing quite so much as retirement for a brief period from the hundreds of people and events attracting and holding attention so that few have or take the time to peacefully and earnestly inquire into their own method of living. Such introspection would pay almost any of us.

The lesson also illustrates the value of great faith. The course of the lesson is as follows:
