Controlling Poultry Parasites

Parasitacants used in the poultry house destroy contagious diseases and some parasites such as mites and ticks. Lime wash made from freshly slaked lime is a good disinfectant, as are also a 5 per cent carbolic acid solution and cresol which may be purchased ready for use. Kerosene emulsion, used particularly to kill mites, is another satisfactory disinfectant. To make it have a half pint of hard laundry soap into a half gallon of soft water and boil the mixture until the soap is dissolved, then remove from the fire and stir into it, while hot, 2 gallons of kerosene. If used to kill mites, 1 quart of the kerosene emulsion is mixed with 10 quarts of water, it used as a disinfectant, stir well and then add 1 pint of crude carbolic acid or of cresol and again stir until well mixed. Disinfectants may be applied to walls or ceilings by a brush or spray pump. Care should be taken that the disinfectant is applied in a thorough manner so as to reach all cracks and crevices and all parts of the boards and roosts. Feeding and drinking troughs should be disinfected by pouring boiling hot water over them and drying them in the sun.
