Recipes Are Given For Baked Potatoes

Some people may not realize that all potatoes are not good baking potatoes. A good baking potato should be fairly large, smooth, clear skinned, of mealy texture when baked. A number of people have been kind enough to hand in recipes for baking potatoes, for which we thank them.

STUFFED BAKED POTATOES

Take ten medium sized potatoes. Wash and bake. Cut in half lengthwise and scrape out of shells and mash them. To this add one medium size onion finely minced, 1 small can pimentos cut fine, 1/2 cup butter, and salt and pepper to taste. Beat altogether and refill shells. Cover top with grated cheese. Put in pan and place in oven and bake about 15 or 20 minutes longer. A little paprika may be sprinkled over top when removed from oven, if desired.

Wash as many large or medium sized potatoes as desired, bring to a boil, drain and rub over outside with butter or lard, and bake. This method leaves an attractive shiny skin and does not have that shrunken appearance as in the old way. If one wishes, the core may be removed lengthwise and the potato stuffed with cheese before putting in over. This is very delicious.

SUNSHINE POTATOES

Wash thoroughly six medium size potatoes and bake till well done. While still hot cut potatoes in half-length ways. Scoop out centers, beginning carefully to not break shell. Mash and season with butter, salt
